- 1) JJAP is published by IOP Publishing (IOPP) on behalf of the Japan Society of Applied Physics since 2019. Submission system is changed from JJAP Special Issue of Ultrasonic Electronics (USE) 2019. Authors submit their paper using ScholarOne Manuscript (S1M).
- 2) When the editor decides that the submitted paper needs revision, the authors must resubmit within 21 days. If the author delays over 21 days, the paper is automatically rejected. When the author need more than 21 days for the revision, before the deadline, the authors must apply for the extension of the deadline to JJAP team: jjap_special@jsap.or.jp (special issues).

 - 1. The authors must cite the corresponding USE proceeding paper in the manuscript.

- B) The copyright for all contents in the Symposium Proceedings belongs to Symposium on USE Organizing Committee, and one cannot use any contents in the proceedings without permission. However, when the authors of the proceedings use figures and tables in their proceedings paper for their corresponding JJAP special-issue paper, the authors can use them without permission. In such case, the authors must refer their proceedings paper.
